# Carthage Civic League, Inc. Minutes for October 21, 2019 Meeting

#### **Reports:**

- Fire Lt. Bishop from House 2 reported 208 runs this past month. 178 were EMS, 13 were fire and 17 runs not related to ems or fire. He also spoke about the importance of smoke detectors in the home. Smoke detectors are free at the firehouse, or a fireman can bring one to the home and install it. He answered several questions including where to place smoke detectors and when to change batteries.
- **Police** Officer Erica Brazile reported that there have been some robberies in the area between 68<sup>th</sup> and 72<sup>nd</sup> streets in Carthage. These are under investigation. The ongoing problem in front of Buckets Bar has been resolved for now. It has been noticed and reported to the Police that people are gathering on the property of the Vine Street Market. Suspected drug deals and acts of prostitution happening on that property will cause problems for the business there. Officer Brazile will speak to the owners of the business about this. She advised us once again to report any suspicious activity to the non-emergency number 513-765-1212. Collect as much information as possible to report when you call. And calls to that number are documented. This data is important, so keep calling when you see something suspicious.
